

Marriage on March 19, 2015

Checklist for wedding HK

➤ For Formality of attendance on March 16, 2015

1. Passport (travel documents we used to enter Hongkong and should be match to the travel document that we sent during wedding application.)
2. Confirmation letter (It's the one that the HK Marriage Registry sent us in email and we just need to print this.)

➤ Wedding ceremony on March 19, 2015

1. We should bring our two witnesses above 18 (We have to remind them to bring their passport with them on our wedding day.)
 - We can find them in front of the philippine embassy or in the park
2. Our passport or travel document (the same that we presented on the formality of attendance)
3. HK \$715 for the wedding fee
4. Ask for 2 copies of our wedding certificate for German embassy, CFO, consulate in Hong Kong (We can ask this directly on the day of our wedding in Cotton Tree drive Registry office before the ceremony so they can prepare this for us)
5. Certified copy of marriage certificate will be HK\$280 cash per copy
6. We should wear at least formal attire that is appropriate for wedding occasion. (Don't forget to bring long sleeve clothes, black shoes and pants)

➤ Report of Marriage in Philippine Consulate in Hong Kong

1. Our Marriage certificate (the one that was given to us from the Marriage office in Cotton Tree Drive before the ceremony started)
2. Wife's NSO authentication of Birth certificate
3. Wife's NSO authentication of Cenomar (Photo copies of our valid passport (Never forget to always bring our travel document because we will be needing this more often for wedding process)
4. 4 copies of (ROM) Report of Marriage form (this could be downloaded on the website of Philippine consulate for reporting of marriage)
5. Processing fee of HK\$200.00 for our Report of Marriage in person

➤ Apostille authenticated Marriage Certificate

1. In cash of HK\$ 125 per seal (for personal application)
2. They will hand us the receipt of payment and we will show this to the Apostille Service office at LG1 in day to pick up our Marriage certificate authenticated with the Apostille.
